Finally, all students will be provided with a **work experience pack in June** with the full details of their placement, which we recommend students to contact before they start in July.

# TESCO LAUNCH STRONGER STARTS APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME

Tesco have recently announced the launch of their new Stronger Starts Retail Apprenticeship programme, as part of their commitment to help young people achieve a stronger start in life.

Stronger Starts is one of the few apprenticeship programmes that doesn't require any qualifications or experience as entry requirements.

After completing the programme, apprentices gain a Level 2 National Standard in Retail, which is the equivalent of 5 GCSE passes.

The programme opens for applications on **24th June 2024**.
